2009 REVISED Operating Schedule:

OPEN DAILY through April 30

OPEN WEEKENDS ONLY May 1 through the end of 2009 season

NEW FEES AS OF MAY 1, 2009:

TENT SITE: \$30 per night

CABIN: \$60 per night

Due to low usage last year and the high expense of keeping facilities staffed and maintained, camping at Little Basin will be available weekends only beginning on May 1 for the rest of the 2009 season. In addition, fees have been adjusted slightly to help cover the expense of keeping the property open for recreational use.

All existing reservations for camp stays through April 30 will be honored. Reservations beginning May 1 or later will be limited to weekends Friday-Sunday. Existing weekday reservations from May 1 on will be cancelled. Individuals with such reservations will be contacted and informed of the cancellation, and will be issued a full refund. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

POST and Sempervirens Fund are pleased to accommodate continued recreational use of Little Basin. However, given the economic slowdown, state budget cuts, the bond funding freeze, and resulting delay in transferring the property to California State Parks, the cost of keeping Little Basin open daily has become prohibitive. POST and Sempervirens Fund continue to work with State Parks to transfer the property and integrate it into Big Basin Redwoods State Park.

Thank you for your support of Little Basin, and for helping us preserve this remarkable recreational treasure in the heart of the Santa Cruz Mountains for people here now and for generations to come.
